

What does it mean to be excluded from CILEx?

If the Disciplinary Tribunal exclude an individual from CILEx this will mean they are no longer allowed to use their designatory letters (for example FCILEx or ACILEx etc.) or associate themselves with CILEx in any way.

The Disciplinary Tribunal may express exclusions in different ways and will be published on the CILEx Regulation website as set out in the table below:

Type of Exclusion	Duration of Publication
Exclusion	Indefinitely or until a successful application for reinstatement of CILEx membership or authorisation is made
Indefinite exclusions or Exclusions with no time specified	These remain published until the minimum time has been reached. <i>(Example – if a member or an authorised person has been excluded for a minimum of 4 years, publication will cease once 4 years have passed)</i>
Indefinite exclusion with a minimum time specified before an individual can reapply to CILEx**	These remain published until the minimum time has been reached <i>(example – as above.)</i>
Indefinite exclusion for a minimum period with no reference to reapplication to CILEx**	Indefinitely or until a successful application to vary the ongoing requirement is made
Exclusion where there is an ongoing requirement to inform another party by the CILEx member/authorised person of the exclusion**	Indefinitely or until a successful application to vary the ongoing requirement is made. The ongoing requirement to notify of exclusion may still apply even if you as a member or authorised person have been reinstated.

What does each type of exclusion mean?

1. If a person has been excluded or indefinitely excluded from CILEx with no time specified this means they are no longer a member of or authorised by CILEx. It also means they will not be readmitted or re-authorised by CILEx. They do however have the right to reapply which will be considered by the Professional Conduct Panel.
2. If a person has been indefinitely excluded with a minimum time specified before a person can reapply for readmission or reauthorisation it means that the minimum time period must have passed before a person can reapply to CILEx. For example 'a person who is indefinitely excluded and who is not to reapply to CILEx for five years' will remain excluded after the five years and until they have made a successful application to be reinstated.
3. If a person has been indefinitely excluded for a minimum period with no reference to reapplication to CILEx this means that a person may reapply after the minimum exclusion period has passed. However they will remain excluded until such time as a successful application for reinstatement is made.
4. If a person has been excluded from CILEx with an undertaking or condition attached this means they must continue to comply with that undertaking or condition during their period of exclusion. If they are readmitted they will be required to continue to comply with the condition or undertaking unless it is removed by an order of the Disciplinary Tribunal or Professional Conduct Panel.
