IGR and Greater Independence

Overall Programme Status: GREEN



IGR implementation has been the focus since the last Board update. Training has been rolled out, compliance documents and processes have been designed and documents finalised. There has been a significant amount of work to undertake but we are now ready to request sign-off on IGR compliance from both Boards.

With this project we have taken a 'good enough approach', meaning that we are confident that we fully comply with all of the IGR and the LSB's requirements, however, post-implementation there will be the need to undertake some additional work to refine or revisit a couple of areas to optimise their workability in a live environment.

It is also hoped that the Greater independence project can now be revisited with a view to capitalising on the momentum and ideas generated by the IGR project.

Excellent progress. All necessary actions have now been completed and recorded via the Action Plan and Evidence Log. Compliance logs and processes are in place, as is the infrastructure to ensure that there is a 'home' for the IGR at officer and NED level.
