I work for a mid-sized private practice law firm which is growing rapidly. The firm has strong core values in supportive intelligent business focused work, but at the route of delivering these values is the employees.

In liaison with the Management Board of the firm the Social Committee, of which I was a member, were tasked with bringing the firm together on a personal and social level. Emphasis being placed upon staff welfare and wellbeing, and the importance of an enjoyable work life.

To achieve this, the business aims were to achieve a better collegiate work environment without large financial impact on the business.


So the best price I have been able to source is £142.06 incl VAT delivered for 100 pieces (per design) – this is actually a very good price!

The minimum order is 100, so we cannot get any smaller quantities (I have found other companies that do small amounts, but they are more expensive).

We are therefore looking at a total cost of £568.24 for 400 presentation folders. There are no artwork fees as I have done this all myself.

Can you please talk to to get approval for this? It is supper urgent given the timescales (and the weather is causing delivery delays!), so if you could get the nod today I can submit the artwork for a proof and then process in time for the end of next week.

Unfortunately I cannot see personally on this – I am not in the office, and given the time sensitive nature of it, it really needs to be today.

With regard to background on pricing, it is simple. £142.06 per 100 is by far the cheapest for a double sided wallet. A local competitor quoted at £332 per 100 for only a single sided wallet. And the average for single sided was coming in at around £200-£300 per 100. Excluding artwork.
