Reflect on performance: As a claims manager within the dental team, I often have high caseloads which require detailed letters of response to be prepared in a timely manner. I have performed by diarising when letters of responses are due and ensuring that important deadlines are met.

Strengths and weaknesses: My strength is that I have experience in handling a large volume of cases and in drafting robust letters of responses in cases that require a good defence. I am always willing to work in a cohesive team in order to resolve cases. My weaknesses include the need to develop my knowledge on certain types of cases, for example vicarious liability cases which have been increasing in recent months.
