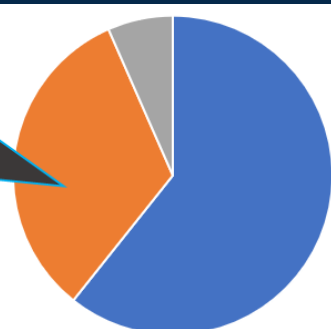
## How do we use your fee?

The 2023 Practising Certificate fee funds CILEx Regulation and the Levies\*  
The fee funds only **regulatory activities** at CILEX and  
CILEx Regulation (CRL), through the activities we undertake, the services we share  
(e.g. IT services) and the Levies we pay to other regulators.

elements:

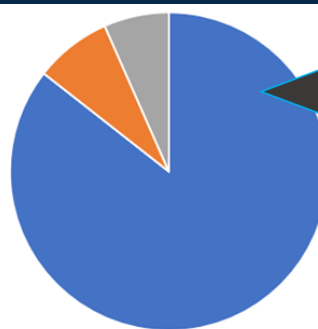
- CRL 60.7%

### CILEX income 2023

- ⇒ CILEX takes 32.7% of the fee, which funds activities allowed under the Legal Services Act.
- ⇒ CILEX is primarily funded through its membership, qualifications and training activities.

### CILEx Regulation income 2023

- ⇒ CRL takes 60.7% of the fee to partly fund the cost of regulation for CILEX's regulated community, including all CILEX members.
- ⇒ CRL is also funded by income from other sources (e.g. application fees for qualifying employment assessment).

The remaining 6.6% is paid to the Levies.

\*The Levies cover the costs of the Legal Services Board, the Office for Legal Complaints and the Office for Professional Body Anti-Money Laundering Supervision.
